

## **How to find things out at Trillium**

### **August 13, 2009**

- ❖ Check the school's website frequently for calendar and school information <http://www.trilliumcharterschool.org>. The website is kept up-to-date and is easy to navigate.
- ❖ Join the parent listserv for official announcements. Go to the following website and follow the instructions for subscribing:  
<http://lists.trilliumcharterschool.org/mailman/listinfo/trillium-parent>.
- ❖ Ask teachers at school, or via email:  
[teacherfirstname@trilliumcharterschool.org](mailto:teacherfirstname@trilliumcharterschool.org).
- ❖ Check out teachers' blogs—go to the website for links, e.g.,  
<http://www.trilliumcharterschool.org/index.php?page=3---4---5> for the middle school blog links.
- ❖ Talk to your Classroom Liaison.
- ❖ Check the white board calendar and bulletin boards in the front lobby area.
- ❖ Flyers and newsletters are often put in take-home folders (in the lower school) or handed to students in the upper school. The school newsletter is also posted on the website each month.
- ❖ Attend monthly TFT (Together for Trillium, our answer to the PTA) meetings (or just come when you can!): check the calendar on the website for dates & times.
- ❖ Check at the front desk.
- ❖ Talk to a Board member—any of them would be happy to answer questions—check the website for their information:  
<http://www.trilliumcharterschool.org/index.php?page=board-bios>. If you want to be more involved in overall school issues, attend a Board meeting and see where you can help!
- ❖ Join the "TrilliumCommunityDiscussion" listserv for networking, business promotion, resource sharing and discussion. It does not get a huge amount of traffic but can be a great way to share information with other families.
